Changed traffic conditions on Newell Highway between Narrabri and Moree from 10 August 2022

A range of projects are taking place along the Newell Highway between Narrabri and Moree including ARTC's Inland Rail Narrabri to North Star project, Transport for NSW maintenance works, and heavy duty pavement upgrade of the Newell Highway being delivered by lead contractor Fulton Hogan.

Work activities and timing

From the **10 August 2022** for approximately **four weeks**, weather permitting, the following works are taking place simultaneously between Narrabri and Moree:

- **Pavement widening works for Inland Rail** near Bobbiwaa Creek.
- **Clearing works and the installation of barriers** to prepare for the upgrade of the Newell Highway just south of Moree and around Bellata as part of Transport for NSW's heavy duty pavement upgrade Narrabri to Moree project.
- **Heavy patching works** for Transport for NSW essential maintenance works between Gurley and Moree from early to mid-August. From the 15 August work will commence north of Moree.

How will the work affect you?

Ongoing delays of at least **fifteen minutes** should be expected when travelling between Narrabri and Moree. Transport for NSW will continue to keep the community updated on work activities occurring.

Wide load vehicles should plan ahead, check signage, and register their trip with 1800 741 636 (option 3)

The **Woolabrar Rest Area** just north of Bellata will also be intermittently closed from **15 August** over the next 12 months. Motorists are advised to use **Tookey Creek Rest Area** located 3.6 kms north of Woolabrar Rest Area.

Traffic Changes

These works will require **single lane contra-flow closures and reduced speed limits** across all these locations. Motorists are advised to allow at least **fifteen minutes** additional travel time.

Motorists should expect ongoing changed traffic conditions along the Narrabri to Moree corridor throughout 2022 to support the delivery of these critical projects. Motorists are advised to drive to the conditions and always follow the directions of signs and traffic control.
