Beecroft Station Upgrade

Project Update April 2021

The Beecroft team completed a significant amount of scope during the March 2021 work weekend.

The following was achieved:

- installation of the lift shaft structure within the old booking office, and completion of the extension of the lantern building
- installation of the lift shaft structure for the lift on the Wongala Crescent side of the station
- completed piling for the foundations to support the future platform canopy
- installed the platform drainage network
- completed the internal demolition of the existing toilet facilities to enable the refurbishment work.

Work will continue in April and includes:

- · concreting work associated with the lift structures
- installing cladding and finishings to the lift structures
- drainage and concrete work on the platform
- refurbishment of the existing platform toilet facilities to convert the bathroom into a family accessible toilet.

Equipment to be used includes excavators, concrete trucks/pumps, delivery trucks, power tools and hand tools.

Mid-week work - 6 and 7 April

Work is planned to occur between midnight and 5am on 6 and 7 April 2021. Temporary framework structures will be installed above the existing stairs to enable a suspended slab to be built above the stairs during normal construction hours to enable construction of the new lift landing on the platform. This work is planned outside of station operation hours to minimise any disruption to commuters. Access through the underpass will remain open.

Station toilet closed - temporary toilet available

The existing toilet in the station building will be temporarily closed **until mid-June 2021** while it is upgraded to a family accessible toilet. A temporary unisex toilet is available for use at the Sutherland Road entrance to the pedestrian tunnel. The temporary toilet is available during station opening hours.

Signage is in place to help with these temporary changes.

Ongoing station access changes

The stairs and ramp between Wongala Crescent Commuter Car Park and the station will remain closed until **late 2021**, to allow for construction of the new lift to be carried out. Customers can continue to access the station via the ramp from Wongala Crescent, and the pedestrian underpass tunnel.

Construction hours

Standard construction hours are 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays.

For the safety of staff, customers and the community, some work will be completed outside standard construction hours. We will notify nearby residents and businesses in advance if we need to work outside these times.
