# **Project update**

September 2021

Construction activities on the Bexley North Station Upgrade recommenced from 31 July 2021, in line with restrictions introduced by the NSW Government to help keep our communities safe.

Should these restrictions change based on advice by the NSW Government, which may impact the timing of our work, the community will be notified. The safety and wellbeing of our workforce and the wider community is our highest priority. These works are in line with the current Public Health Orders and a COVID-19 Safe plan is in place, including masks and QR codes.

## **Upcoming work**

The Bexley North Station Upgrade is progressing well, with fit out of the new lift continuing. Construction activities will continue in September, subject to change due to NSW public health orders, and include:

- installation of cladding, metal works and services on the platform, new concourse and stairs
- footpath upgrades on the western side of Bexley Road, between Shaw Lane and Kingsgrove Avenue
- concreting, asphalting, paving, landscaping and installation of street furniture in the Kingsgrove Avenue commuter car park
- fit out of the new lift and installation of tactiles on the platform
- delivery of materials and equipment.

Equipment to be used includes trucks, concrete trucks and pumps, excavators, rollers, small mobile cranes, power and hand tools.

## **Night work**

Work will continue in September to upgrade the western footpath on Bexley Road. Work will include installation of new paving and will be carried out on the following dates:

- 6pm Thursday 16 September to 6am Friday 17 September 2021
- 6pm Friday 17 September 2021 to 6am Saturday 18 September 2021
- 6pm Friday 24 September and 6am Saturday 25 September 2021 (if required)

Installation of tactiles on the station platform will also be carried out during this time.

Footpath and lane closures will be in place to ensure work can be carried out safely. Traffic control and signage will be in place to assist pedestrians and motorists with these changes.

Equipment to be used includes paving saws, lighting towers, trucks, power and hand tools.



### Kingsgrove Avenue parking and access changes

To create a safe working area for construction of the access ramp and car park upgrades, the following temporary parking and access changes will continue:

- temporary closure of the Kingsgrove Avenue Commuter Car Park until late 2021
- temporary closure of up to 20 car parking spaces along the rail corridor boundary fence
- temporary lane width reduction.

Motorists, please allow extra travel time and follow the direction of signage including reduced speed limits while temporary changes are in place.

#### Station toilets

The existing female toilet in the station building is temporarily closed until late 2021 to enable refurbishment of the station toilets. The former male toilet has been refurbished and will operate as a unisex toilet during this time. Once the project is completed, the station will feature a new family accessible toilet and a unisex ambulant toilet.

#### **Construction hours**

Standard construction hours are from 7am to 6pm every day, including public holidays.

We understand extending construction hours to include weekends and public holidays may cause disruption, with all efforts made to minimise impacts where possible and ensure strict environmental conditions relating to noise, vibration and dust management are adhered to.

Where weekend and night work is required, measures will be implemented to reduce impacts wherever possible, such as turning off vehicles when not in use, positioning construction equipment as far away from residential areas as possible, using non-tonal reversing beepers, and monitoring noise levels.
