

Electric, hybrid and hydrogen vehicles safety labels

December 2021

Safety labels help emergency services follow safety procedures if an electric, hybrid or hydrogen vehicle is in a crash.

Light vehicle

Labels must be attached to **all** number plates on:

- electric, hybrid and hydrogen **light** vehicles
- electric, hybrid and hydrogen **heavy** vehicles modified or manufactured after 1 January 2019.

The labels **must** be clearly visible at all times. From 1 January 2022 penalties, including a defect notice and/or fine, apply to the operator or driver of vehicles that don't comply.

Replacement labels

Free replacement labels are available from any Service NSW Centre. You can also get them from your mechanic or motor dealer.

How to attach

- Remove the backing from the label. This will help hold it in place while you take the next steps.
- Attach in an upright position on the number plate (not on the frame or cover).
- Don't obscure any characters or the state of issue.
- Fix into place so it's secure.
